Scales of Light

I. Scales of light

I John 1:5 “God is light.”

Genesis 1:3 “And God said let there be light.”

A. He who is light said let there be light.

B. This is where we see creation flowing through the Word and being created by the Word. (Colossians 1:15-18; John 1:1-5, 6-11).

C. Centuries ago, Isaac Newton discovered that light shining through a prism produced a rainbow.

*** A prism is three sided and has 7 colors.**

D. We see that there are seven spirits of God!

(Revelation 3:1; 4:5; 5:6)

E. We see the seven Spirits of God in Isaiah 11:2, Rev. 3:1.

F. Science reveals that an atom is composed of a nucleus and electrons. Even small particles (protons and neutrons) make up the nucleus.

Particle physics has further discovered that protons and neutrons are a collection of extremely small light particles called “quarks.” Quarks have a constant interchange of even smaller substances called “gluons” and “mesons” which are comprised of color and anti-color that are constantly moving in and out of the quark. There are six flavors of quarks. They can successfully account for all known mesons and Baryons (over 200). The most familiar baryons are the protons and neutron. You can google Quantum Physics to further blow your mind!

G. Remember God said “let there be light”, This pronouncement created the substance from which all things are created. That substance is light.

(Romans 1:20)

II. Color Scales: Understanding Color

A. Why does color exist?

B. Is there a spiritual connection to color?

C. We see in Exodus 28 The breastplate of the High Priest there were 12 different colored stones. Why?

D. In Exodus 26 we see that the tabernacle's coverings were comprised of bright colors, just like the stones built into the walls of the New Jerusalem.

E. In Rev. 4 John saw a rainbow around the throne of God. why?

*** Did you know that there are 24 colors/hues around a color wheel and 24 elders around the throne. Why?**

F. There are three color spectrums. Each has three primary colors and three secondary colors. - The additive, the Subtractive and the Artist's spectrums.

***Lets look at a couple of links to further dive into this issue of light.**

G. The additive scale (Spirit)

The scale deals with light, not pigments.

Primary colors: red, green, blue

Secondary colors: yellow, cyan, magenta

1. this scale radiates color rather than reflecting or absorbing it.

2. Combining the six colors results in white or transparent, light (color).

H. The Subtractive Scale (Soul)

When light illuminates an object, the colors that are seen are those that are reflected back to the eye.

The object that you see absorbs all other colors. So, colors are subtracted from those that are seen.

Primary colors: yellow, magenta, cyan

Secondary colors: red, green, blue

1. This scale reflects color.

2. the colors combined construct an opaque black color in the center or middle.

I. The Artist's Scale (Body)

The color that is seen is the color that is absorbed by the light.

Primary colors: yellow, red, blue

Secondary colors: orange, green, violet

1. This scale absorbs color. In other words, some colors become distinct as the object absorbs other colors from the light that shines on it.

2. Together, the colors produce a color which is near black or very brown.

3. Imagine if there were color spectrums for each of the three parts of the man - spirit, soul, body.

J. Jesus made a statement concerning light in Matt. 6:23.

*** In making parallels with quantum physics, we could say Jesus acknowledged dark light.**

*** John 3:19, II Corinthians 11:14**

K. Interestingly enough we see a two greek words in the New Covenant which mean multi-colored.

***Poikilos it means multi-colored**

both words manifold and various are translated from this greek word!

*** the hebrew word for manifold is rabab: to be or become many or much.**

the hebrew word for various is rigmah: embroidered, many colors, stones of various colors, various colors.
