### I. Shoes of Peace

- a. The word for peace in hebrew is shalom and it means: **Completeness, soundness, welfare, peace.**

**completeness (in number)**

**safety, soundness (in body)**

**welfare, health, prosperity**

- b. The pictograph for the letters that make up shalom paint a picture of the removal of chaos that causes anxiety!

- c. Shalom or peace is mentioned 429 times in the KJV Bible.

- d. Peace truly is a weapon.

**\* Now the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace. (James 3:18)**

**\* If the household is worthy, let your peace come upon it. But if it is not worthy, let your peace return to you. (Matthew 10:13)**

**\* And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. (Luke 10:6)**

**\* And the God of peace will crush satan under your feet shortly. (Romans 16:20a)**

**\* Do not think that I came to bring peace on earth. I did not come to bring peace but a sword. (Matthew 10:34)**

**e. Jesus spoke to the storm in Mark 4:39 and said peace, be still! And the wind ceased and there was a great calm.**

**f. Mercy and truth have met together, righteousness and peace have kissed. (Psalms 85:10)**

**g. We are to pray for the peace of Israel so that we may prosper!**

**\*Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you. (Psalms 122:6)**

**h. The mind of Christ brings life and peace. (Romans 8:6; Philippians 2:5-8)**

**i. Jesus left his peace with the disciples.**

**\* Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. (John 14:27)**

**j. There was a law of peace offerings in the O. C.**

**\* This is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings which he shall offer to the Lord: (Leviticus 7:11)**

**k. Jesus paid for our peace!**

**\* But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. (Isaiah 53:5)**

**l. Peace is only lost when our minds are held captive by another!**

**\* You will keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on You, Because he trust in You. (Isaiah 26:3)**

**m. There are times when the Lord will fight for you and all you have to do is hold your peace in the process!**

**\* The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace. (Exodus 14:14)**
